

OUTREACH EAST QUEEN OF DIAMONDS PROGRESSIVE RAFFLE RULES

May 20, 2025, to May 13, 2026

- A new deck of cards, including Jokers, will be used for each game.
- Cards will be shuffled, placed face down and inserted into envelopes and sealed.
- The envelopes will be shuffled and numbered 1 to 54 in accordance with Michigan Gaming Directives.
- The numbered envelopes will be placed in a locked display cabinet at The Davison Hotel by Outreach East chairpersons.
- Tickets will be sold for \$1.00 each and may be purchased at The Davison Hotel or from sellers authorized by Outreach East chairpersons.
- **To insure fairness for all participants, any tickets that are bent, folded, mangled or in any way altered will not be entered into the drawing and the money will be refunded. Outreach reserves the right to refuse service to those that do not comply with the rules.**
- Owners and employees of The Davison Hotel and suppliers of the raffle, chairpersons or co-chairpersons **MAY NOT PURCHASE TICKETS.**
- 60% of the ticket sales goes to prize money; 40% to Outreach East.
- One ticket will be drawn on Tuesday at approximately 7:00 p.m.
- The purchaser with the weekly winning ticket picks an envelope number from the display board.
- To win the jackpot, the envelope must contain the Queen of Diamonds. If it doesn't but contains a Pay Card as listed on the prize payment schedule, the winner will receive the Weekly Ticket Winner prize and any Pay Card prize.
(Example: Stage 1—\$25 for weekly ticket winner prize plus \$20 for any King = total winnings of \$45.)
- If the Queen of Diamonds is not chosen, the jackpot rolls over to the next week's drawing and will continue to build until the Queen Of Diamonds is drawn.
- If the purchaser is not present at the drawing and did not designate an envelope number on the ticket stub, a third party will be selected at random to choose a number.
- Winners must provide proper identification and information to Outreach East for withholding taxes from winnings as required by the State of Michigan.
- During the last drawing date before the State Gaming License expires, tickets will be drawn and envelopes chosen until someone draws the Queen Of Diamonds and wins the current jackpot.
- After each drawing all ticket stubs will be destroyed.
- Ticket sales will end at 6:45 p.m. 'Tues. ' and can resume after the current week's drawing is completed.
- In the event of an emergency or inclement weather, the raffle will be held the next business day at The Davison Hotel at 7:00 p.m.
